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Writing a composition ~~can be~~ a very frustrating experience. But through patience and organization one can ^{overcome} many of the problems involved in it. There are many individual steps that the writer should use to help him make the composition easier to write, and more effective.

These steps are as follows:

I - Choose the topic of the essay and decide on the position you will take dealing with this topic.

II - Jot down all that comes to mind about this topic. Then eliminate ^(on what basis?) all useless information, and concentrate on only the important information that will be used in the essay.

III - Take these ~~ab~~ important ideas and ^{organize} ~~put~~ them into outline form.

Once you have the main points of the essay, then concentrate on supporting evidence. When the outline is complete, ^{one can} begin to look towards the actual writing of the paper.

IV - Begin either with the actual "development" of the rough draft, or the introduction of this first draft. (I prefer to begin with the outline
